From the Vice Chancellor's Desk

Bee Vectoring: Nature's Solution for Sustainable Agriculture

Dear Colleagues,

The world is facing several challenges in agriculture, especially under the threat of global warming and climate change. The researchers of the world and India are putting several efforts to find innovative and sustainable approaches for climate resilient agriculture. Specifically in India, the efforts are being made to reduce the input costs for enhancing the farmers' income. One of the potential solution which has gained significant attention is bee vectoring, a natural and eco-friendly technique that utilizes bees to deliver biological



control agents and beneficial microorganisms directly to plants. This groundbreaking approach holds immense promise for improving crop health, reducing chemical pesticide use, and promoting ecological balance in agricultural ecosystems.

Bee vectoring involves harnessing the natural behavior of bees as efficient pollinators and equipping them with a dual role of delivering microorganisms and biological control agents to plants during their pollination visits. While foraging for nectar and pollen, bees come into contact with powdered substances, such as fungal spores or bacterial cells that have been carefully formulated to combat specific plant diseases or pests. As bees move from flower to flower, they deposit the beneficial microorganisms directly onto the plant's reproductive structures, such as the pistil or stigma, effectively inoculating the plant and providing protection against harmful pathogens.

The bee offers a sustainable alternative to conventional pesticide applications by leveraging natural pollination behavior, the technique delivers biological control agents in a targeted and precise manner, reducing the need for broad-scale spraying of chemical pesticides. This approach significantly reduces the environmental impact and potential health risks associated with conventional pesticide use. This technic can provide effect control of plant diseases and pests which enhances crop production. By introducing these protective agents directly to the plant's reproductive structures, bee vectoring enhances crop resistance and boosts overall plant health.

In addition to providing crop protection, it enhances pollination, resulting in increased fruit set and improved crop yield. The reduction in use of chemical inputs in agriculture through such biological control provides minimizes harm to beneficial insects, birds, and other wildlife, fostering a balanced and thriving ecosystem within agricultural landscapes.

Bee vectoring technology is currently being applied to a range of crops, including strawberries, blueberries, almonds, tomatoes, and cucurbits. The technique has shown promising results in controlling diseases such as Botrytis gray mold, Monilinia fruit rot, and Fusarium wilt, as well as managing pests like thrips, whiteflies, and aphids. Ongoing research and development efforts aim to expand the range of microorganisms used, optimize formulations, and refine application techniques to maximize effectiveness.

Looking ahead, bee vectoring holds vast potential for revolutionizing sustainable agriculture. As the global community strives to address food security and environmental challenges, harnessing the power of bees through bee vectoring could prove to be a significant step towards a more sustainable and harmonious future for agriculture.

JAU's Performance in India Higher Education Rankings 2023-24

India Higher Education Rankings 2023-24 declared by the Education World Magazine in New Delhi. JAU, with an overall score of 915 out of 1300, secured second (2nd) rank in Gujarat and seventh (7th) rank in India among the state and central agricultural universities participated. Dr. V. P. Chovatia, Hon'ble VC, JAU, lauded the efforts of the faculties and students contributing to the university rankings and appealed to recommit themselves for the university to consolidate and improve its performance at the state and national levels.



Performance in NIRF Rankings 2023-24

JAU was also ranked 38 in the first-ever India Rankings 2023 for the Agriculture & Allied Sectors released by the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) of the Ministry of Education, Government of India. The ranking was released on June 5, 2023. Out of the key parameters analyzed for ranking by the national agency, JAU scored 72.69 out of 100 in Teaching, Learning & Resources (TLR) whereas in the Graduation Outcomes (GO) and Outreach and Inclusivity (OI) the scores were 53.71 and 42.71, respectively. The overall score of JAU was 42.34 out of 100.

Annual Groundnut Workshop

The Main Oilseeds Research Station, JAU, Junagadh and Directorate of Groundnut Research, ICAR Junagadh collaboratively organized a three-day "Groundnut workshop 2023" during May 24 to 26, 2023 in which more than 150 scientist from different AICRP centres across the India participated. The workshop covered scenario of



groundnut production and productivity of different state of India and major challenges faced by groundnut scientists. The interventions for breaking the yield barriers using biotechnology, pre-breeding for tolerance to abiotic and biotic stresses, identifying nutrient dense groundnut genotypes and low anti-nutrient factors, enhancing quality traits, integrated disease and pest management etc. were discussed along with need to strengthen basic and collaborative research.

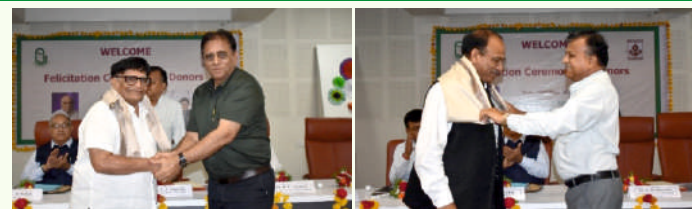
Visit of Dr. R. C. Agrawal, DDG (Edn.), ICAR and ND (NAHEP)

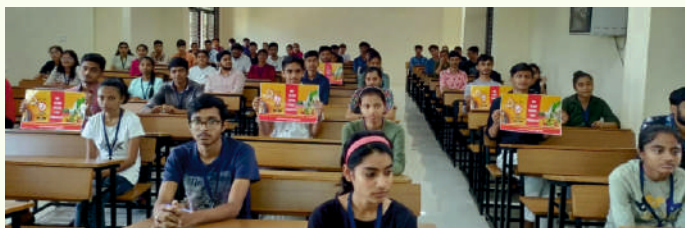


World No Tobacco Day
