First day: 10.03.2023

On 10th March, inaugural session was started at 03:00 pm Patel Samaj, Bhatiya under the guidance of Dr. K. B. Parmar, Principal, Polytechnic in Agriculture, JAU, Sidsar, Junagadh. He addressed the NSS Volunteers about importance of NSS in conserving cultural heritage and also development of rural areas. He also provided the information of various NSS activities and shared his experience. Sarpanch of Bhatiya village Shri Dineshbhai Haribhai Suvagiya gave the basic information about village situation and motivate to NSS volunteers. All the volunteers and Prof. S. H. lakhani was visited village site, primary school and gaushala along with volunteers. All the volunteers got basic information about village.

Second day: 11.03.2024
