History

College of Agriculture, Junagadh was established in June 1960 as the First Government Agricultural College in Gujarat State. It remained affiliated with Gujarat University, Ahmedabad till the year 1967. The affiliation was transferred to Saurashtra University, Rajkot in 1968. The College achieved a major milestone by getting affiliated with the newborn Gujarat Agricultural University in 1972. The College came under the jurisdiction of Junagadh Agricultural University with the quadfurcation of erstwhile Gujarat



Agricultural University into four new Agricultural Universities from May 01, 2004. The education medium was in vernacular language (Gujarati) during initial years of the College and was changed to English medium from the year 1977. The College has been accredited by ICAR, New Delhi.
