

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1. PREAMBLE OF THE INSTITUTE

1.1 Introduction

India is an agrarian economy and agriculture is considered as the mainstay of our economy. In the era of globalization major structural reforms are taking place in the agriculture sector. Still the Indian agriculture faces several challenges like, stagnation in productivity, huge post-harvest losses and marginal share in world trade due to WTO's stringent sanitary and phyto-sanatory standards. As a result of globalization, Agri-Business is transforming structurally in to a complex and well-disciplined business. Agri-Business is the latest growing sub-sector of India having business the highest potential.

In this competitive and rapidly changing world, every resource, enterprise, organization and every project must be managed professionally in order to sustain and prosper. These challenges will place unparallel demands for increase in capabilities of tomorrow's Agri-Business managers.

In view of these reforms, Agri-Business education becomes a premier need of State Agricultural Universities of India. Recognizing the importance of professional human resources in Agri-Business sector, the Junagadh Agricultural University has started PGIABM in 2008 by the resolution of Government of Gujarat, Department of Agriculture and Cooperation (Vernacular) No.JKV-122008-362k-2, dated 10/06/2008 and Notification of Junagadh Agricultural University, (vernacular) No.JAU/Regi/ACA-1/ Board of Man.-12/20618-697/2008, dated 30/07/2008.

Initially the functioning of PGIABM started under the esteem guidance of I/C Principal Dr. P. G. Butani (Principal, College of Agriculture, J.A.U., Junagadh) and Nodal officer Dr. K. A. Khunt (Professor, Department of Agricultural Economics) in collaboration with the Department of Agricultural Economics. The first–semester was commenced and completed at the Department of Agricultural Economics. In the year 2009 the PGIABM was shifted to the building of Agricultural Technology and Information Centre. In this year, most of the vacant teaching posts were filled up and PGIABM started in full flagged manner. Finally, the institute was shifted to its new building as on 01/10/2012.

Initially, the students of the institute were resided in the hostels of College of Agriculture. Institute's newly constructed hostel "Chanakya" was inaugurated as on 01/12/2013 by Shri Babubhai Bokhiria, the Hon. Minister of Agriculture and Cooperation, Govt.of Gujarat which has accommodation as well as all requisite facilities for 84 students. The institute and hostel buildings are surrounded by a beautiful garden and landscaping due to the effort of staff, students and our dedicated laborers.

1.2 Mission and Objectives

The ABM program at this institute is planned to develop management workforce to cater agricultural industry which serves as a good option for career development in corporate sector. PGIABM has very good combination of theoretical and practical education system. The institute thus visualizes that; management will have to talk with agriculture more intimately and hence this stride in blending agriculture with management education. This will create a new breed of managers who are well equipped with knowledge to face stark realities of Agri-Business uncertainty and yet create value out of the techno economic complexities of current century. The hall mark of this institute is, not to walk on the beaten path but to strike new routes. The enterprising and pioneering spirit can be witnessed throughout the history of Junagadh Agricultural University. The curriculum offered by PGIABM is according to 4th Deans Committee of ICAR and some additions by the expert committee of this field. 
